

SELECTMEN MEETING

APRIL 14, 2010

PRESENT: Michael Blaudschun, Chair; Margaret Schillemat & Warren Hammock, Selectmen.

1) Selectmen Meeting was opened by Michael Blaudschun at 7:05pm. Seconded by Warren Hammack. Motion carried unanimously. All paperwork was read and signed by the selectmen and any issues taken brought to fruition.

2) Warren said that Lisa Sievert will be the fifth person on the Town Hall/Library Committee. This makes the five member committee complete. The first meeting of the committee will be on Saturday April 24th at 10:00am. The selectmen would like Owen to open the town hall and please stay for the meeting.

3) Peder Schillemat came and delivered to the selectmen a book on the Munsonville Cemetery Grid Map as a guide to graves located in the Munsonville Cemetery. Peder produces this as his Eagle Project for the Nelson Cemetery Board. He also presented a book to the Cemetery Committee.

4) Carol Heath came to present pictures, in her camera, to the selectmen about the condition of the land by the road and what the snow plows are doing to it. She would ask that they not go so close to her stone walls and keep the debris from going over the walls and on the grass. The selectmen will speak to Mike Tarr road Agent about this problem. Mike Tarr will try to come to the selectmen meeting next week.

5) Troy Tucker and Earl Creasey will come to next weeks selectmen's meeting for 8:30pm.


