

Present: Michael Blaudschun, Chair; Margaret Schillemat & Warren Hammack. Selectmen.

Others Attending: Rick Lothrop, Fire Chief; Pamela White, Troy Tucker, Timothy O'Meara, Dawn Amer, Treasurer; Mike Iselin and Trisha Jones.

- 1) All paperwork was signed and read by the selectmen, including minutes of the last selectmen's meeting.
- 2) Pamela White and Karen Hersey of the Moving in Step Group came to ask the selectmen if they would sign a letter acknowledging and recognizing The Moving in Step Group as a legitimate and independent organization with shared interests and goals for the good of the town. The selectmen signed the letter for the group.
- 3) The selectmen want the Town Hall Committee to come to the next selectmen meeting on June 30, 2010, to speak about what they have done so far on the Town Hall project.
- 4) The Town ball field will be used by the Rotary Club for a fund raiser on June 26, 2010. Owen will mow the field before that date. Owen will mow the triangle and have the tree trimmed out front of the Old Brick School House.
- 5) Troy Tucker, Site Plan Review Officer; spoke to Timothy O'Meara about his building of a deck without a building permit and asked him to stop and apply for a permit ASAP. Troy also spoke to the selectmen about another problem that was addressed in the May 15, 2010 selectmen's meeting. It appears that nothing has been done to correct the violations that were brought forth. The selectmen asked that a letter be sent, registered mail, with the violations mentioned and explaining there will be an inspection the week of July 6<sup>th</sup> of the property.
- 6) Mr. O'Meara came to the meeting with a building permit which the selectmen denied because he had to go to the ZBA for a variance. Mr. O'Meara took applications with him and will apply for the variance.
- 7) Dawn Amer, Treasurer; would like to have reports from the last treasurer, Tom Buttrick for the last 6 years, as we need to have those backups in our possession. Dawn also spoke about the Quick Books system finally coming to fruition and that all reports of spending etc. will be able to be done by July 14, 2010. Budgets will be done by next week.

8) Mike Iselin came to ask what the Town Policies are on volunteer issues. The selectmen don't know of any policies for the volunteer positions. But suggested that maybe the school, cemetery or library could be of help.

- 9) Trisha Jones, chair of the Cemetery Board; came to let the selectmen know that the new board consisted of Teri Upton, Peter Brnger, Edith Norton, Judy Lang and Trisha Jones as Chair.
- Trisha reiterated that Al Struthers is retired but is still working with Owen Islin. Owen is an acting Cemetery Sexton at this time.
  - Memorial Day went off without a hitch. Both Owen and Al worked to clean up the cemetery.
  - Keene Monument will be out to do the pillars and the contract work at the cemetery.
  - Trisha is researching everything she can.
  - The Munsonville cemetery will be mowed by Owen more often to keep it looking nice. If Owen needs someone to work with him he needs to give advanced notice.
  - Owen needs to get the mowers out of the police area and into the town barn.
  - The cemetery phone will be disconnected.
  - There are no lots being sold in the Munsonville cemetery.
  - The newest section across the street has all been surveyed and pinned.

Trisha will keep the selectmen informed of any changes that come before the cemetery board.

10) Chief Richard Pratt brought before the board a grant for a Lenco Bearcat Specialized Mission Vehicle to be used for homeland security etc. This is in conjunction with the city of Keene Police Department and other area towns. The selectmen support this pursuit of a grant for this purpose.


11) Mike Blandschun motioned to adjourn the meeting at 10:10pm. Margaret seconded the motion. Motion unanimously carried. Meeting closed.


